What we do for ICBMs and Nuclear Deterrence?

- Provide safe, secure and effective sustainment of Launch Facilities and Launch Control Centers
- On-site depot field teams for PDM and disposition maintenance to support warfighter readiness

History:

- Rivet MILE Legacy – previously considered phase maintenance on facilities
- ICBM facilities recognized as part of the weapon system in 2016 to enhance mission readiness
- Separate units absorbed into OO-ALC to initiate programmed depot maintenance in FY17

ICBM LF & LCC PDM:

- 57 Launch Facilities per year (450 total)
- 6 Launch Control Centers per year (45 total)

Capabilities:

- Top Secret, Critical PRP positions
- In shop local manufacturing at each site
- Disposition [107] depot level workload
- CDL, Heavy Haul, HVAC, Electrical licenses
- Explosive Ordinance and weapons handlers
- 65 general and special purpose vehicles

Financials:

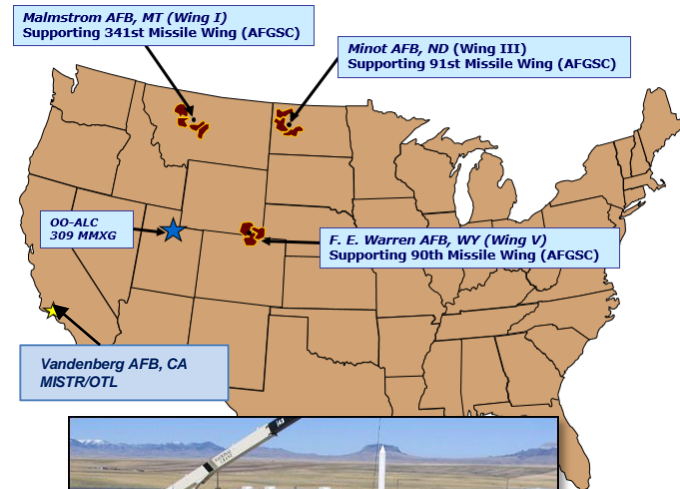
- \$39,909,483 in revenue for FY19

- Utilization of *Art of the Possible*
- PRP re-alignment to be self-sustaining
- Facility expansions with mezzanines
- Cooperation with GBSD development
